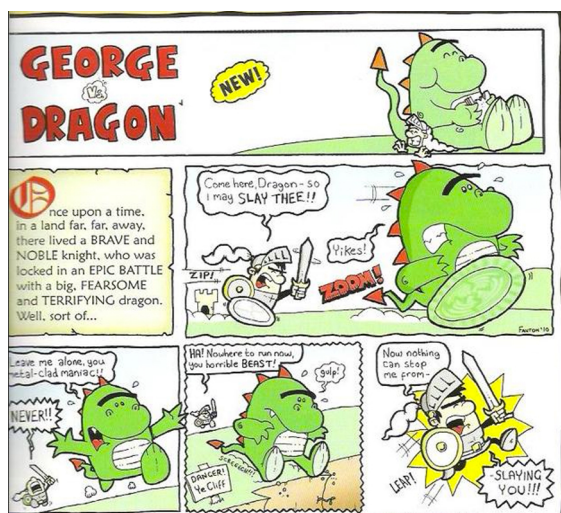


Sant Jordi Contest 2015

1. Comic Contest

This is your option!!



RULES:

1. **Topic of the comic:** *Social Networking and Sant Jordi's legend.*
2. **Number of contestants:** individual/pairs
3. **Categories:** All the students from ESO may participate. There is a unique category.
4. **Length:** 1 sheet (DIN A3).
5. **Prize:** there will be three prizes but they can be declared void.
6. **Deadline:** 7th April. Hand in the comic in a big envelope with your pseudonym on its front. A smaller envelope with your pseudonym and your real name inside must be included.

The original comics will remain at the school

RULES:

1. **Topic of the poem:** Write a poem (three verses maximum) about Spring or the seasons in general.
2. **Number of contestants:** individual
3. **Categories:** All the students from ESO may participate. There is a unique category.
4. **Length:** 3 verses
5. **Prize:** there will be three prizes but they can be declared void.
6. **Deadline:** Friday 27th March. Hand in the poem in a big envelope with your pseudonym on its front. A smaller envelope with your pseudonym and your real name inside must be included.

The original poems will remain at the school

3. Storytelling contest



Do you like writing stories? Are you creative, imaginative and expressive? Don't doubt, write your story!

RULES:

1. **Topic of the story:** You have to continue the story. Choose your level and one of the options. You must also invent a title for the story

Level A

Option 1

The alien landed on the Earth on a Tuesday morning. He looked like a human, he talked like a human, and he walked like a human. Nobody would know he was an alien. "I need a good name," he thought. "I know. I'll call myself . . .

Option 2

I was walking down the street when I saw a small wooden box by the road. Suddenly, I heard a voice. "Help! Let me out of here" To my surprise, the voice was coming from the box...

Level B

Option1

When Jake woke up on Wednesday morning, he thought it was just another day, as usual. He got dressed, ate breakfast, and prepared to go to school. When he went outside, however, he realized that something, was very, very different. . .

Option 2

It all started when I was walking to school. I was waiting to cross a street when I looked down, and there it was: an envelope, with thousands of euros inside. . .

2. **Number of contestants:** individual

3. **Categories:** There are two categories.

Level A: 1st ESO /2nd ESO

Level B: 3rd ESO / 4th ESO

4. **Length:** 1 sheet (DIN A-4) maximum

5. **Prize:** there will be four prizes, two for each category but they can be declared void.

6. **Deadline:** Friday 27th March. Hand in your story in a big envelope with your pseudonym on its front. A smaller envelope with your pseudonym and your real name inside must be included.

For this category, we'll choose the best two stories of every group and the writings will be sent to Senator Patrick Burs school from Calgary, Canada. They'll be our jury.
